COVID-19 Policies (rev. 10-2021)

As always, our number one priority is the health and safety of you, our valued guest, and our employees. Having traveled away from your home, we appreciate that you may have concerns, and want you to understand that we cannot guarantee your health- However, we are taking a number of actions to enhance our already high standards of safety, health and cleanliness on our campus.

General Information:

- If you are eligible, Camp Washington strongly encourages you to be vaccinated **asap**.
- Camp Washington continues to monitor the guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and is following all health and safety guidelines provided by the local department of health.
- If you are feeling uncomfortable gathering with others, we suggest you wait until a time that feels better for you and your circumstances.
- Fully vaccinated guests are **not** required to wear masks indoors or outdoors. Any guest is invited to wear a mask anywhere on campus, if they are more comfortable doing so.
- Non-vaccinated guests **must** wear masks indoors and adhere to social distancing when both indoors and outdoors.
- Camp's already rigorous cleaning regimens and protocols have been increased. Enhanced cleaning and sanitization practices have been put in place throughout campus, and the overall cleaning frequency has been increased.

Employees:

- Vaccinated employees are no longer required to wear masks indoors or outdoors as per the State of Connecticut guidelines. In the event of any non-vaccinated employees, they will wear masks whenever they are near guests or other employees.

Wellness Stations:

- We have provided wellness stations with hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes that are available throughout campus.
- Complimentary masks are available for guests upon request.

Dining:

- All dining venues and kitchen areas are following the local department of health guidelines for food safety and kitchen sanitization.
- Community Events- We will determine what works best for each event, and may require that all guests be vaccinated for some gatherings. We will notify guests and share this information in advertising and communications prior to sign-up.
- Weather permitting, and when it is possible for our staff to make accommodations, we will offer outdoor seating options.
