COVID-19 Policies (rev. 2/1/2022)

As always, our number one priority is the health and safety of you, our valued guest, and our employees. Having traveled away from your home, we appreciate that you may have concerns, and want you to understand that we cannot guarantee your health- However, we are taking a number of actions to enhance our already high standards of safety, health and cleanliness on our campus. We realize this virus is ever-changing, and rely upon science and the expertise of physicians and health care professionals to guide our policymaking. These policies are being reviewed on a regular basis and will be adjusted, as needed, to best address the needs of the majority of our guests.

General Information:

- All guests, visitors, and campers must be fully vaccinated (as defined by the CDC) and show proof of vaccination upon arrival to campus.
- The retreat leader or designee will be responsible to communicate to participants and gather proof of vaccination for their group, presenting documentation to the front desk upon arrival.
- Additional, detailed protocols for summer camp will be made available to all camp families prior to the opening of camp.
- Camp Washington continues to monitor the guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and is following all health and safety guidelines provided by the local department of health.
- If you are not feeling well, we ask you to stay home and suggest that you be tested if you are experiencing COVID related symptoms.
- If you are feeling uncomfortable gathering with others, we suggest you wait until a time that feels better for you and your circumstances.
- Fully vaccinated guests are **not** required to wear masks indoors or outdoors. Any guest is invited to wear a mask anywhere on campus, if they are more comfortable doing so.
- Camp's already rigorous cleaning regimens and protocols have been increased. Enhanced cleaning and sanitization practices have been put in place throughout campus, and the overall cleaning frequency has been increased.

Employees:

- Vaccinated employees are no longer required to wear masks indoors or outdoors as per the State of Connecticut guidelines. In the event of any non-vaccinated employees, they will wear masks whenever they are near guests or other employees, both indoors and outdoors.
- Any unvaccinated employee, having approval from the Executive Director to be employed and on campus, must provide a written negative PCR test upon reporting to work each week.

Wellness Stations:

- We have provided wellness stations with hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes that are available throughout campus.
- Complimentary masks are available for guests upon request.

Dining:

- All dining venues and kitchen areas are following the local department of health guidelines for food safety and kitchen sanitization.
- Weather permitting, and when it is possible for our staff to make accommodations, we will offer outdoor seating options.

#### Community Events:

- We will determine what works best for each event, and **currently** require that all guests be vaccinated for all gatherings. However, due to the ever-changing nature of this virus, we may change protocols for certain events. In that case, we will notify guests and share this information in advertising and communications prior to sign-up.
